/Harris County Community Services Department ANNUAL ACTION PLAN AMENDMENTS PUBLIC NOTICE

April 23, 2021

The U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requires that Harris County develop a 3- to 5-year strategy document which states the community development and housing needs of the jurisdiction and annually submits, in a single application for funding, its request for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Emergency Solutions Grants (ESG) and HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME) Program funds. Other funding addressed includes the Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP) I and III and Community Development Block Grant – Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) funds. This strategy document is called the Consolidated Plan, and the single application for funding is called the Annual Action Plan (AAP). When significant changes occur to the Consolidated Plan and subsequent AAPs, Harris County must propose amendments to be reviewed by the public for a 30-day comment period. The Harris County Community Services Department (HCCSD) proposes the following amendments:

2014, 2015, 2016, 2019 and 2020 CDBG Funding:

Project C2019-0024 Harris County Precinct 1 - Airline Improvement District Zone 2 Nicar Street Water and Sanitary Sewer Improvements (Airline), Deobligate \$514,453.48 in 2019 CDBG Funds. Total project funding, including previously awarded amounts, will be \$553,960.52.

Project C2019-0024 Harris County Precinct 1 - Airline Improvement District Zone 2 Nicar Street Water and Sanitary Sewer Improvements (Airline), Obligate \$18,535.80 in 2014 CDBG Funds, Obligate \$410,659.86 in 2015 CDBG Funds, and Obligate \$85,257.82 in 2016 CDBG Funds. Total project funding, including previously awarded amounts, will be \$1,068,414.00.

Project C2020-0026 Harris County Precinct. 2 - Parkwood Estates Water Distribution System Phase II (Aldine) Obligate \$221,171.32 in 2018 CDBG Funds, Obligate \$41,328.68 in 2017 CDBG Funds. Total project funding, including previously awarded amounts, will be \$1,146,624.00.
