ANNUAL ACTION PLAN AMENDMENTS
PUBLIC NOTICE

January 18, 2022

The U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requires that Harris County develop a 3- to 5-year strategy document which states the community development and housing needs of the jurisdiction and annually submits, in a single funding application, its request for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Emergency Solutions Grants (ESG) and HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME) Program funds. Other funding addressed includes the Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP) I and III, Community Development Block Grant – Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR), and Community Development Block Grant – Coronavirus (CDBG-CV) funds. This strategy document is called the Consolidated Plan, and the single funding application is called the Annual Action Plan (AAP). When significant changes occur to the Consolidated Plan and subsequent AAPs, Harris County must propose amendments to be reviewed by the public for a 5-day comment period. The Harris County Community Services Department (HCCSD) proposes the following amendments:

ESG and CDBG Funding:

Project 2020-031k The Salvation Army of Greater Houston/Community-wide COVID-19 Housing Program Bridge to Permanent Supportive Housing Case Management/Navigation Services (COVID-19)(Countywide). Obligate \$178,017 in 2020 ESG CARE Act-1 Funds and Obligate \$299,895 in 2020 ESG CARE Act-2 Funds for a project budget of \$2,390,862. Organization has an additional project (C2020-039) with an unchanged budget of \$2,869,839. Total project funding for both projects, including previously awarded amounts will be \$5,260,701.
